

PLANNING FOR YOUR CHILD WITH SPECIAL NEEDS

THE HARDEST PART OF ANY LARGE TASK IS GETTING STARTED

- ✓ Step One: Gather all records into a large stackable Rubbermaid tub
- ✓ Step Two: Divide into topics and keep them from mixing up with file folders temporarily. Topic Categories could be: Medical, Education, Testing, etc.
- ✓ Step Three: Get a large three ring binder and add dividers or cardstock to keep the topics divided neatly.
